

Standard hotels for this tour:

Friday Harbor

Discovery Inn

This small family-owned inn has a friendly staff and a mid-20th century rustic charm. The rooms are clean, pleasant, well-appointed and recently renovated – all with private bathrooms. Most rooms are spacious with the exception of those on the third floor where there are sloping ceilings.

The Discovery Inn is on the outskirts of town; less than a mile from the town center and the ferry.



Eastsound

Inn at Ship Bay

This eleven-room inn is set at the top of a bluff with unobstructed views over the water. The Inn is built around the historic 1869 Adam's orchard farmhouse. All rooms have views, are nicely furnished and well maintained. The staff are extremely knowledgeable and friendly.

The Inn at Ship Bay is 1 mile from Eastsound but has a good restaurant on site (closed Sunday & Monday)



Classic hotels For an upgrade of \$400.-pp

Tucker House

Stay as the guests of Anna and David in this luxury inn. Just a block from the bustling downtown, this charming inn consists of a cluster of buildings centered around two charming Victorians.

Rooms are romantic and tastefully decorated while breakfast is a three-course feast with some ingredients flown in on the owner's plane!



Eastsound

Outlook Inn

One of the original buildings in Eastsound – built in 1888 – this classic hotel sits in the center of town commanding superb views across the bay. There are a range of tastefully renovated rooms on the property. We typically book rooms with views and private bathrooms. The hotel's restaurant – the New Leaf Café – is one of the best in town. The Outlook Inn only serves breakfast Thursday through Monday. When not available, we provide vouchers for breakfast elsewhere in town.

The New Leaf Restaurant is typically open Thursday through Monday.

Friday Harbor House

A modern boutique hotel right on the waterfront. Most rooms have balconies and fireplaces and many have water views. While the hotel has its own restaurant it is also within easy strolling distance of the town's other dining options. There is no spa but an in-room massage can be arranged.



Eastsound

Rosario Resort

The centerpiece of this hotel is a beautiful 1904 waterfront mansion. Rooms are spread over the 40-acre grounds – a walk from the main mansion. Many rooms have dramatic views of the bay. The resort also has a full-service spa, three pools, and two restaurants. We book the deluxe rooms or suites in this category. The Rosario Resort is 6 miles south of Eastsound at the bottom of a steep, 400-foot descent.
